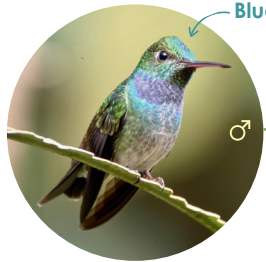

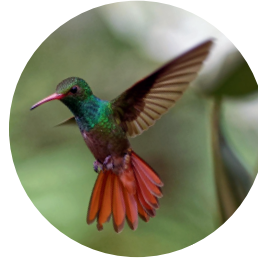

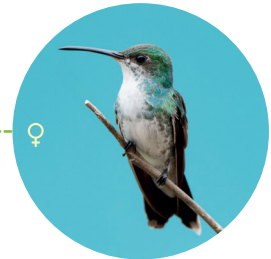

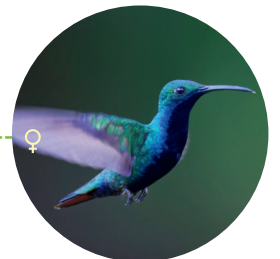

The Canopy Tower is an ecolodge dedicated to the observation of birds and nature. It is located inside Soberanía National Park, just 45 minutes away from Panama City. The tower was constructed by the United States military ca. 1963 for the surveillance of the Panama Canal. It was closed in 1995 and left vacant, awaiting better days. In 1997, a concession was obtained to transform the tower into one of the best birding destinations in the world, which finally opened its doors in 1999.

This guide was created to facilitate the identification of hummingbirds that visit the feeders located on the Canopy Tower grounds. The feeders offer a great opportunity to closely observe and photograph these amazing birds. They are cleaned daily with hot water and soap, and filled with a combination of sugar and water. Many flowering plants are located on the Canopy Tower grounds, which the hummingbirds visit too. We hope you enjoy this guide as the hours fly by watching these special birds!
